Since 2002, Operation Canasta supports non-profits organizations that help Argentina's neediest children through annual grant awards up to \$3,500. More than 70 NGO received funds used effectively serving the needs of our target population; children living in conditions of economic deprivation.

FUNDACIÓN GRANO DE MOSTAZA

PURPOSE: Social and educational development of children and their families. The program targets populations that do not have access to secondary schools and provides scholarships and housing for children and adolescents along with their families to facilitate access to an education. "Proyecto de Vida" grants scholarship for education.

BENEFICIARIES: 67 high schools grant scholarships in the communities of La Paya/Cachi, Salta. In 2020, this Foundation granted 243 scholarships.

OPERATION CANASTA supports Grano de Mostaza with 15 high school scholarships in La Paya, Cachi Salta.

FUNDACIÓN AGUAS

PURPOSE: to build a system of safe water consumption.

BENEFICIARIES: 142 children, 12 educators and 450 families in the community of a kindergarten and pre-kindergarten, number 193, located in the Chaco province.

OPERATION CANASTA: supports Fundación Aguas with the construction of a tank to collect rain water and a system of water treatment.



FUNDACIÓN HUERTA NIÑO

PURPOSE: To build agro-ecological gardens in rural areas throughout the country in order to achieve a sustainable solution to hunger.

BENEFICIARIES: Children and young people, from 5 to 17 years of age in unfavorable situations, or attending rural schools. At present this organization is helping 25 schools benefiting 5,730 persons including youngsters and their families.

OPERATION CANASTA: supports Huerta Niño with purchases of materials for the construction and training of vegetable gardens in schools in different areas of Argentina.







INSTITUCIÓN FATIMA

PURPOSE: provide therapeutic educational space to children with deaf-blindness.

BENEFICIARIES: 51 students and 71 families.

OPERATION CANASTA: supports with financial help for maintenance and building repairs.
